Constitution Task Force November 2015

At the BOT request, this task force will propose changes to the Constitution to bring us closer to a policy based governance structure. I am requesting a charge from the BOT to cover the areas below.

Sections to be changed

- * Board responsibilities and Board Committees (removing the specific list from the Constitution entirely).
- * Removing requirement that BOT review member names before status is changed, allowing the status change process to be defined at policy level.
 - * Adding wording re appointing a moderator at members meetings.
- * Adding a process to suspend the COM when we have an interim minister (that might be able to be a board policy but then we probably need to put "writing policy for elected committees" as a board responsibility in the Constitution).
 - * Cleaning up typos, errors.

Timeframe

There is a 2-month Constitution required timeframe to get 2 member meetings called to discuss, change, and ratify the new Constitution. We need to determine how to slot this in around the spring pledge drive.

Membership

Currently the following people have agreed to serve: Mary-Jane Cross, John Mason, William McEvoy, and Sal Mollica. It would be good, I think, to have one more board member on the task force.
