Capital Campaign Planning Team's Status Report to the Board of Trustees March 19, 2019

Since the Capital Campaign Planning Team (CCPT) last reported to the BOT, we held a successful town hall meeting on February 24th and we continue to work behind the scenes towards the May 5th member vote as the Annual Canvas progresses.

Town hall meetings were held after both services on February 24th. Approximately, 25 people attended after the 9am service and 50 after the 11am service. Rev. John spoke about the process of the capital campaign thus far, the CCPT was introduced, John Turmelle presented a slide show on the state of our building and the architect, Goody Clancy, introduced themselves. Questions and comments were recorded during each town hall and responses from the CCPT were provided in this past Soundings under Capital Campaign Planning Team News – Document 6 (attached). We will be posting the video of the 11am town hall for those who could not attend in the next Soundings.

There will be another town hall on April 14th. Goody Clancy will update the congregation on their status and we will allow the congregation to again voice their thoughts/concerns/suggestions. This will the last town hall prior to the May 5th vote at which time the members will decide whether to proceed with a capital campaign. The CCPT is working to provide sufficient information to the members prior to the vote so they can make an informed decision.
