MINISTERIAL FELLOWSHIP COMMITTEE STATEMENT OF CONGREGATIONAL SPONSORSHIP

One of the requirements for a candidate seeking Unitarian Universalist fellowship is sponsorship by a UU congregation. The purpose of this requirement is to ensure familiarity on the part of our UU ministers with UU congregational life and encourage congregations to take a responsible role in the recruitment, preparation and assessment of our future ministers.

Sponsorship of a candidate indicates confidence in the person's potential and suitability for UU ministry. The Ministerial Fellowship Committee and the Ministries and Faith Development Staff Group will regard congregational sponsorship as evidence that the person seeking fellowship is actively committed to Unitarian Universalism and the institutions which uphold our faith tradition.

In most instances, sponsorship of a candidate will be determined by the congregation or

its representative body, and not by congregational vote.
